- 2) A.  $6 \times 4 = 4 \times 6$   
 B.  $6 \times 1 = 6$   
 C.  $(6 \times 4) \times 2 = 6 \times (4 \times 2)$   
 D.  $(6 \times 4) + (6 \times 2) = 6 \times (4 + 2)$

- 3) A.  $8 \times 9 = 9 \times 8$
